Depression and Impact



The estimated economic impact of depression was estimated at 215 Billion dollars (in 2010)

Just under half of the costs are "direct costs"

More of the costs are indirect (including presenteeism and underperformance)

Depression is more than half of Social Security Disability costs

Depression is treatable

People recover from depression

There are good options available for treatment of depression



Figure 1. Mean Healthcare Research Use in the Past 6 Months Among 3-Category PHQ-9 Subgroups*




ED indicates energency department: PHO-9, Patient Health Questionnaire-9.







Chart 2. Nonfarm payroll employment, seasonally adjusted, September 2019 – September 2021


COVID Impact on Employment



- Not all areas recover equally
- People with Bachelor's and above degrees are doing much better than people without a Bachelor's degree
- Hotel, Child Care, Restaurants and some parts of health care still have not recovered
- · Women and minorities are a disproportionate share of employees in those areas
- Rapid transition for many from office to work from home (and virtual school environments as well)

- · Some fare better than others
- · Loss of job
- · Loss of social connectedness
- Isolation from friends/family/coworkers/schoolmates
- Higher rates of anxiety (CDC notes 3.4x higher rates Sept. 2021)
- Higher rates of depression (CDC notes 3.4x higher rates Sept. 2021)
- Higher rates of substance use
- · Higher rates of domestic violence
- · Higher rates of suicide
