Despite her success in law, Maggie felt a creative void in her life and was looking for a new path that would allow her to not only flex her entrepreneurial muscle but also build a brand that marries her love of design and culture with her passion for entertaining.

After attending Le Cordon Bleu, Maggie recognized a void in the marketplace for chocolates that were just as decadently designed as they are delicious, and founded Maggie Louise Confections in 2013. In 2014, the young company's products were selected to appear on Oprah's Favorite Things list, and their products have been on the Today Show and have been featured in Food+Wine, Vogue and other publications.
